Our printing inks are made from vegetable oils.



The paper for our envelopes and the board for our cards come from well-managed, sustainable and accredited sources.



Our card packaging is plastic free; you can choose to have them packed in biodegradable vegetable starch bags or sustainably-sourced card wallets.



We do not apply additional foils or glitters to our cards which have damaging impacts on the environment in their manufacturing and inability to be recycled.



All our waste printing board and packaging is sent for recycling.



Our general waste is processed so that it does not go to landfill.



Our whole factory and office suites have been converted to low energy lighting that switches off when not in use.



Our heating system has been upgraded to energy efficiency boilers.



As all of our design and production happens under one roof there is no need for unnecessary transportation of stock.

The life of a bag

Our biodegradable bags are made from PLA (polylactic acid) plastic which is derived from renewable sources such as corn, potato or beet starch.



To dispose of the bags, put them in your kitchen, food or garden waste bin where it will either:

- Go to an industrial grade composting plant or landfill and within 6 months it will have biodegraded into CO₂, water and biomass.
- Go to an incinerator and become water and CO₂.
